



Worship Leader

The worship leader is a contract position responsible for planning, preparing, and leading congregational worship services designed to promote authentic worship, encouraging spiritual engagement with the congregation and proclaiming the Gospel.

Key responsibilities: Selecting appropriate music, leading rehearsals, coordinating with the Senior Pastor and Audio/Visual Ministry, and fostering a positive worship experience for the church community.

Key duties:

- **Worship planning:** Selecting music for each service, developing worship flow, incorporating scripture readings, and coordinating with the Senior Pastor on the overall worship theme.
- **Leading the worship team:** Managing and rehearsing the worship team (vocalists, instrumentalists) to ensure they are prepared for services.
- **Leading congregational worship:** Facilitating worship through singing, prayer, and scripture readings, creating an engaging and spiritually uplifting atmosphere.
- **Spiritual development:** Maintaining a strong personal relationship with God, demonstrating spiritual leadership within the worship team.
- **Communication and collaboration:** Working closely with the Senior Pastor, church staff, and other ministry leaders to align worship with the church vision.
- **Recruiting and developing talent:** Identifying and nurturing new worship team members.

Required skills and qualities:

- Musical ability: Strong vocal skills, proficiency on an instrument (preferred but not required), and understanding of music theory
- Leadership skills: Ability to lead and inspire others, manage a team effectively
- Communication skills: Clear and engaging communication to guide the congregation in worship
- Spiritual maturity: Deep personal faith and understanding of biblical teachings
- Organizational skills: Ability to plan and execute worship services efficiently
- Servant heart: A genuine desire to serve the church community through worship
